- TUTORING:** Help parents with GED preparation/college assignments or help children with homework and improvement of basic skills. If you are interested in tutoring, please complete a "tutoring information form." Volunteers must attend a tutoring training session, after which they must commit to one volunteer session a week for one year.

- GIFT CLOSET:** Our gift closet, which includes in-kind donations from Bed, Bath & Beyond and other generous donors, is not well organized. We want ACHIEVEability families to feel like these items are in a boutique and not a leftover bin. People who work on this project will help families pick out items for new homes and help parents pick out presents for their children. If you have a couple of hours a week to spend organizing new bedding, children's coats, and birthday presents, we need your help.
 - This is an ongoing project that does not require a time commitment from the volunteer. All we ask is that you come in during normal working hours.
