

These 16 nonprofits are getting some consulting help from Compass



Compass has announced its 2017-2018 round of nonprofit clients.

The local branch of the national organization connects business professionals to nonprofits (http://generocity.org/philly/2016/09/01/compasss-work-behalf-local-nonprofits-will-worth-3-7m-may/) looking for help in board development, funding strategy, strategic partnerships and collaborations, and strategic alignment.

Each of the 16 nonprofits selected will receive about \$150,000-worth of services.
